END USES Information Sheet



End Use	Description
Automotive Purposes	Includes fuels used in passenger vehicles, delivery trucks, bowsers and any other vehicle type that utilises fuel from a fuelling station. Large companies, such as construction companies, may have on-site fuel storage that is filled by bowser from a supplier/distributer. The automotive purpose should only include fuel that is consumed on road (licensed) vehicles. In the case of construction vehicles, in the case of EN590 Diesel fuel, there are 2 types of Fuel Consumption: automotive fuel consumption for transportation of material or equipment and Industrial Fuel Consumption for construction site activity. Fuel consumption by non-road vehicles (such as tractors, fork lifters, excavators) should not be included under Automotive Purposes.
Cooking Purposes	Includes the cooking/heating of food on a small scale in domestic-type cookers/ovens used in staff kitchens or at restaurants. Any production operation involving the manufacturing of Food Products (such as bakeries, biscuits' production, etc.) should be reported under Industrial Processing.
Industrial Processing	Operations related to industrial production of goods in large quantities, services provided in large quantities (such as heating large amounts of water for laundry purposes), or minor operations that do not fall into any of the other end-uses but are unique to a specific sector or enterprise (such as weeding in Agriculture Sector). This end-use also includes the fuels used to run vehicles/machinery that are not typically used on roads such as tractors, forklifts, excavators, and stationary non-road machinery.
Spatial Heating Purposes	Includes fuels used to heat the premises of the company. It excludes those fuels used for Water Heating Purposes . Fuels used for heating which is part of another process fall under Industrial Processing .
Spatial cooling/ventilation and refrigeration	Includes fuels used to cool or ventilate the premises of the company, as well as fuels used for refrigeration.
Water Heating Purposes	Includes fuels used for heating water for sanitary purposes or kitchen use (example geysers). Any fuels used for heating boilers are to be reported under Industrial Processing.

Marine Purposes	Includes fuels used for sea-going vessels whose departure and arrival point are the Maltese territorial waters (not to include international travel), or machinery that is situated on a sea-going vessel.
Electricity generation	Refers to fuels used for self-generation of electricity for example through the use of generators.
